Since the first resin-based composites appeared on the market in the mid-1960's there have been a multitude of products come and go. Looking through the *Dental Outlook* archives we found examples of just a few from the early period.

At the time most products had relatively large filler particles and so wear was a definite problem when the materials were used in load-bearing situations. Colour stability was another limitation and remained until the introduction of light-cured materials.

As can be seen some of the names were quite imaginative!
